From Sixmilecross to the Balkans - Nurse Bella Dixon in Serbia 1915 will be held in Sixmilecross Presbyterian Church Hall on **Thursday 16 June, 8:00 pm.** A Talk by Johanne Devlin Trew, University of Ulster Researcher, who will provide wider context on the war in Serbia at the time that local woman Nurse Bella Dixon was serving in a Serbian Military Hospital in the spring and summer of 1915. Reference will be made to Bella's personal diary of her time in Serbia and the Marshall Tenors will perform a song from Bell's diary that the nurses sang at their hospital camp.
