

## Monday

### **Diane Cusick – global mission worker serving in Zambia**

Diane is on home assignment at present speaking to congregations, PWs and other church meetings about the work she is involved with in Zambia.

- *Pray that people will be receptive to what she has to tell them about early childhood development in Zambia, and may have a greater interest in her work.*
- *Pray for continued good health and safe travel as she continues deputation through to early December.*
- *Pray that the early childhood teachers in CCAP Synod of Zambia are implementing and enjoying the play-based programme during this last term of the academic year.*

### **Evangelical Christian Church in Halmahera, Indonesia**

- *Pray for the life and witness of the church: for its leaders as they work for the unity of the church; for the training of new ministers; and for leaders and members to build and enjoy good relations with their Muslim neighbours.*

- *Pray that many teens will join the course during the intake in January and be positively impacted by it.*

### **National Evangelical Church in Syria and Lebanon (NESSL)**

- *Pray for the leaders and members of NESSL and their witness to others.*
- *Pray for NESSL's various projects to help displaced people and refugees.*
- *Pray for all suffering due to conflicts; and for religious freedom and lasting peace in Syria and throughout the region.*

## Thursday

### **Gareth Parker – community outreach worker in Ballyloughan**

- *Pray for Gareth and for the visitation work, youth ministries, Bible study, discipleship programme and monthly community lunch that he is involved in.*
- *Pray that more people in the area would encounter Jesus in a life-changing way.*

### **Drogheda Presbyterian Church – Rev Damien Burke**

- *Give thanks for God's presence and living Word as Drogheda congregation gather on Sunday mornings to worship and study the book of Exodus.*
- *Give thanks to God for the group of leaders and young people who attended and enjoyed the recent MAD weekend.*

**A very important part of the work of the Council for Public Affairs is to handle often complex issues in the media, with live broadcasts on TV and radio and opportunities to write for local newspapers. Pray for those in our media, as well as those who are interviewed, that there will be real understanding of the issues in the public's mind.**
