Thank you for your continued prayers for this ministry among university students in Spain. So here, as of the 21st of June we are now living in "the new normality", so officially out of lockdown. There are still some restrictions (having to wear a facemask in all public areas, social distancing etc.) but things now feel like back to normal, albeit not the same as before. Church has also been back for a few weeks now and it has been great to attend, although quite strange as facemasks are necessary the whole time and you can't really greet and chat to people as before. It is also a new experience having to sign up to go to church, but only 50% capacity is allowed so this is the best way to control numbers. Praise God for how Spain is entering this new normality and how everything seems to be settling down as we adapt to a new way of doing things.

July this year is looking very different as there is no GBU national student conference and therefore no preparation involved, so I'll have more time to read and plan for September - although this is extremely hard to do as everything is still uncertain. I would appreciate prayer as we finish this academic term and evaluate the year, both as a regional team as well as with the student leaders and seek to plan the following course.
