Moderator's Appeal:

Moderator's Appeal towards the emergency relief effort to help people in Ukraine and those fleeing the conflict. I am confident our members will respond as generously as they have on many previous occasions to similar appeals.

In anticipation of your response, we are immediately releasing £60,000 (€72,035) to be distributed equally to PCI's relief and development partners Christian Aid and Tearfund, and also to the Reformed Church in Hungary (Hungarian Reformed Church Aid). They are all experienced in supplying and distributing humanitarian aid and assistance, not least to refugees and displaced people fleeing regions of conflict, and whenever possible, will extend their reach into Ukraine itself.

Anyone still wishing to contribute to this appeal should do so before the end of May.
